Maj. Gen. Robert M. Haire is the mobilization assistant to the Director, Defense Intelligence Agency, Washington, D.C. In addition to representing the Director at various intelligence community forum, Maj Gen Haire is also the principal advisor to the Director regarding the effective integration and employment of over 1200 Reserve forces supporting DIA from across the services. Further, he is the Director of the Reserve Integration Office, as well as the DIA Chief of Military Personnel.

General Haire received his commission through the Air Force Reserve Officer Training Corps program at the University of Georgia. He began his Air Force career on active duty assigned as the officer in charge of intelligence training for an operational F-15 fighter squadron. He has since served in a wide range of Active and Reserve assignments. He has been an intelligence analyst at the Defense Intelligence Agency; Chief of Intelligence for a Numbered Air Force; and Deputy Chief of Intelligence for Air Force Reserve Command. He deployed in support of combat and counterinsurgency operations in the U.S. Central Command and U.S. Southern Command areas of responsibility. He has chaired a Joint Improvised Explosive Device Defeat Organization (JIEDDO) team charged with reviewing Counter IED technologies. He was recently selected to serve as the Chairman of the Undersecretary of Defense for Intelligence (USDI) Reserve Military Intelligence (RMI) General Officer Steering Committee (GOSC). This GOSC meets regularly to provide advice to the USDI on Reserve Component intelligence requirements, activities, and capabilities. Prior to his current assignment, General Haire was the mobilization assistant to the Deputy Chief of Staff for Intelligence, Surveillance and Reconnaissance,

Maj Gen Haire earned his Bachelor of Arts degree in political science at the University of Georgia. He also earned his Master of Public Administration degree from George Mason University. In 1992 he earned his Juris Doctor degree from University of South Carolina School of Law. In 2006 he earned a Master of Science degree in national security strategy, National War College, Fort Lesley J. McNair, Washington, D.C. He attended the Program for Senior Executives in National and International Security, John F. Kennedy School of Government, Harvard University, Cambridge, Mass in 2010.

Maj Gen Haire began his military intelligence career in November 1981-Mar 1982, as a student, Air Intelligence Course, Lowry AFB. March 1982 - June 1982, he was OIC, Intelligence Support Branch, 33rd Fighter Wing, Eglin AFB. In June 1982 - April 1985, officer in charge, Intelligence Support Section, 60th Tactical Fighter Squadron, Eglin AFB, Fla. April 1985 - November 1987, Soviet integrated air defense analyst, Defense Intelligence Agency, Washington, D.C. In November 1987- August 1989, Soviet air defense interceptor analyst, Defense Intelligence Agency, Washington, D.C. In August 1989 - July 1996, senior intelligence officer, Headquarters 22nd Air Force, Dobbins Air Reserve Base, Ga. In July 1996 - July 2000, Deputy Chief of Intelligence, Headquarters 22nd Air Force, Dobbins ARB, Ga. In July 2000 - July 2001, Chief of Intelligence, Headquarters 22nd Air Force, Dobbins ARB, Ga. In July 2001 - July 2002, Deputy Chief of Intelligence, Headquarters Air Force Reserve Command, Robins AFB, Ga.
