This program is open only to current students enrolled in full-time undergraduate and graduate degree-seeking programs at accredited institutions. Must possess a minimum cumulative grade point average of 3.0 on a 4.0 scale at the time of application and employment. Undergraduate students must complete 60 semester hours or its equivalent at the time of employment. All applicants must be a U.S. citizen at the time of application and are subject to a thorough background inquiry. All interns must be granted a security clearance and successfully pass a drug screening test prior to being made a final offer. The majority of the summer intern positions will be in the Washington D.C. metropolitan area; however, limited opportunities are available at other locations.

Due to the large number of applications received in response to internship opportunities, this vacancy announcement will be closed when a limited (depending on career field) number of applications are received, but no later than 08 September 2017.
