In this era of increasing public and congressional scrutiny of how the Intelligence Community applies its decreasing resources, such an evaluative capability is called for. A sustained effort to ensure that this extremely expensive resource is exploited in the most efficient and effective manner possible would improve collection, increase customer satisfaction and demonstrate the good faith of the Intelligence Community and its awareness of increasing pressure to reduce or eliminate inflexible and inefficient programs.
