CONJEFAMER CONFERENCE IN BOGOTA AND REPEATED AGAIN TO COL BROWN, CHIEF OF THE AFSEC, USMILGP, ARGENTINA. LOAN OF THE AIRCRAFT WAS REQUESTED FOR SIX MONTHS.

2. ~~(S)~~ THE AAF OWNS SIX C-130'S AND HAVE THE CREWS AND MAINTENANCE CAPABILITY. THE AAF WOULD REQUIRED ONLY TRAINING IN THE OPERATION OF SENSING EQUIPMENT.
