DIA received an identical inquiry in April of 2013 and we recommended that [redacted] file a formal DIA Inspector General (OIG) and DIA Equal Opportunity (EO) complaint and/or contact DIA OIG and EO to assist [redacted] with his case. In order to legally address his allegations a formal investigation needs to be initiated by either DIA OIG or DIA EO. These processes are in place to assist DIA employees with these legal matters. DIA will coordinate with all external elements, should his case warrant an investigation. DIA Congressional Relations cannot comment on allegations until a formal investigation is completed.
