5. ~~(C)~~ **RWANDA:** GOVERNMENT AND REBEL LEADERS AGREED TO A CEASE-FIRE BEGINNING AT MIDNIGHT 9 MARCH, AND TO THE RESUMPTION OF PEACE TALKS ON THE 15TH. THE REBELS WILL PULL BACK TO THE PREVIOUS CEASE-FIRE LINE, WHILE GOVERNMENT FORCES WILL REMAIN IN THE POSITIONS THEY HOLD WHEN THE CEASE-FIRE BECOMES EFFECTIVE. A NEUTRAL OBSERVER FORCE WILL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR MONITORING THE NO-MAN'S LAND BETWEEN THE TWO ARMIES. ON THE 8TH, THE REBELS LAUNCHED AN ALL-OUT ATTACK AGAINST THE NORTHERN TOWN OF RUHENGERI, PROBABLY IN A LAST-MINUTE EFFORT TO GAIN AS MUCH TERRITORY AS POSSIBLE BEFORE THE CEASE-FIRE.
