SUMMARY: (U) VENEZUELAN ARMY UNITS FROM FUERTE TIUNA, UNDER  
ORDERS FROM THE CARACAS GARRISON COMMANDER, INVOLVED IN  
HELPING THE ((CHAVEZ)) GOVERNMENT TAKE OVER METROPOLITAN  
POLICE STATIONS. THE ARMY REFUSES TO DISCUSS THEIR  
PARTICIPATION.

TEXT: 1. (U) DURING THE EVENING OF 20021116, BOTH NATIONAL  
GUARD AND ARMY UNITS PARTICIPATED IN AN OPERATION TO TAKE  
CONTROL OF ALL METROPOLITAN POLICE STATIONS IN CARACAS.

ALTHOUGH THE NATIONAL GUARD CARRIED OUT MOST OF THE OPERATION, ARMY SOLDIERS FROM AT LEAST THREE BATTALIONS IN FUERTE TIUNA ALSO PARTICIPATED. ARMY UNITS KNOWN TO HAVE PARTICIPATED INCLUDE ONE EACH MILITARY POLICE, ARMOR AND SIGNAL BATTALIONS, ALL ASSIGNED TO FUERTE TIUNA. MEDIA SOURCES OBSERVED ARMY SOLDIERS TAKING OVER THE FOLLOWING POLICE STATIONS.

- ZONE 2 IN CATIA
- ZONE 7 IN BOLEITA
- ZONE 3 IN CARICUAO
- THE SAN ANDRES COMISARIA
- MARIPEREZ MOTORIZED BRIGADE

TELEVISION REPORTS ALSO SHOWED SOLDIERS AT METRO (SUBWAY) AND BUS STATIONS.

3. (U) DURING HIS WEEKLY TELEVISION SHOW ON 20021117, PRESIDENT HUGO ((CHAVEZ)) COMMENDED HIS MINISTER OF THE INTERIOR, DIOSDADO ((CABELLO)) FOR ORDERING AND CARRYING OUT THIS OPERATION. CHAVEZ STATED IT WAS ESSENTIAL FOR HIS GOVERNMENT TO STEP IN AND PROVIDE CARACAS SECURITY SINCE CARACAS MAYOR ALFREDO ((PENA)) HAD PROVEN INCAPABLE OF PERFORMING THIS CRITICAL FUNCTION. CHAVEZ DEFENDED THE USE OF MILITARY FORCES SAYING THE CONSTITUTION ALLOWS THEIR USE WHEN NEEDED TO RESTORE ORDER.
