~~(S)~~ THE OUTBREAK OF VIOLENCE IN NORTHERN **RWANDA** BY THE **RWANDA** PATRIOTIC FRONT (RPF) THREATENS A CEASE-FIRE AND ONGOING NEGOTIATIONS BETWEEN THE GOVERNMENT AND THE INSURGENTS. IF NEGOTIATIONS BREAK DOWN, THE UNITED NATIONS COULD BE CALLED UPON TO MEDIATE BETWEEN THE TWO COMBATANTS. THE RPF ATTACKS COME AT A TIME WHEN THE GOVERNMENT IS STARTING TO MAKE CONCESSIONS TO THE INSURGENTS. INTERNATIONAL PRESSURE HAD SUCCEEDED IN FORCING PRESIDENT HABYARIMANA TO DISMISS OFFICIALS WHO WERE ENCOURAGING ETHNIC VIOLENCE' RENEWED WARFARE COULD LEAD TO THE RPF AND &OVERNMENT FORCES PARTICIPATING IN "ETHNIC CLEANSING" OF THEIR OPPONENTS, FURTHER EXACERBATING THE SITUATION.
