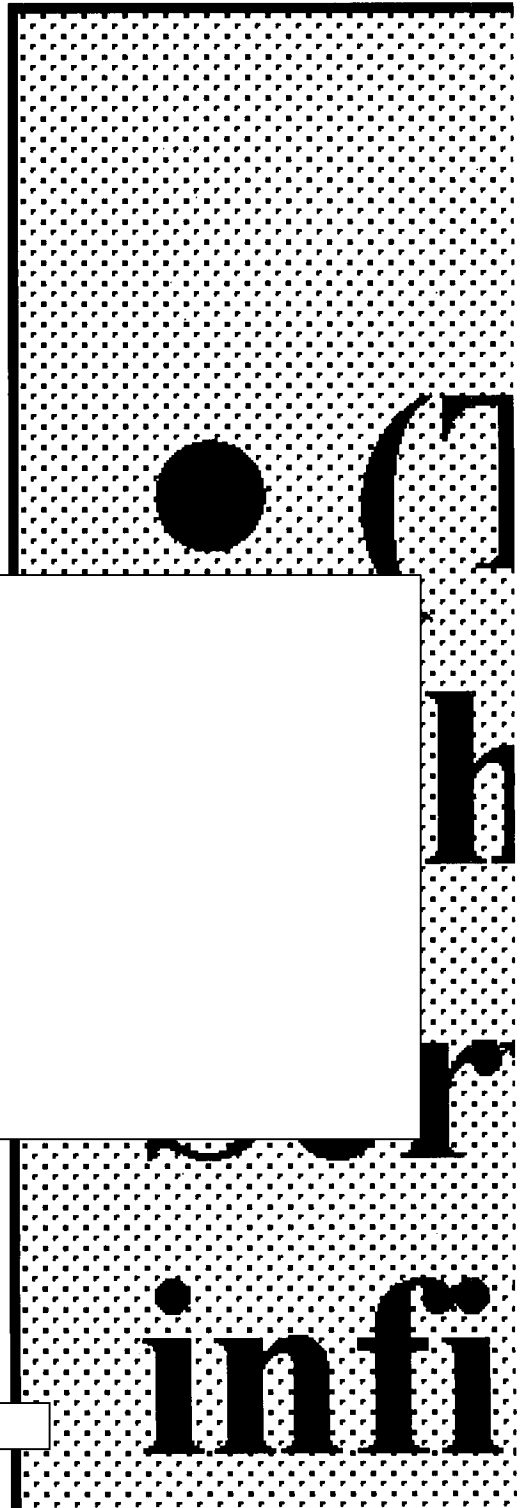

**D. (S) Policy makers who cite no fundamental change in Pakistani behavior are likely attempting to sustain US pressure on Musharraf to ensure Pakistan's "good behavior" prior to and during the Indian Kashmir elections. Given their enduring distrust and skepticism about Musharraf's intentions, they believe he seeks to disrupt and derail the election through continued militant infiltration, support, re-supply, and training.**
