16. ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ SUMMARY: IR FORWARDS AVAILABLE INFORMATION CONCERNING DEATH OF SOUTH KOREAN PRESIDENT PARK. [REDACTED]

A. ~~(S)~~ AT ABOUT 1930 HOURS (LOCAL), 26 OCT 79, PRESIDENT PARK, WHILE ATTENDING A DINNER AT A LOCATION ADJACENT TO THE BLUE HOUSE WAS SHOT AND KILLED ALONG WITH HIS BODYGUARDS. LOCAL NEWS MEDIA REPORTED THAT MR. ((KIM)) JAE KYU, DIRECTOR, KCIA, HAD BEEN ARRESTED AND WAS IDENTIFIED AS THE ALLEGED PERSON RESPONSIBLE. HOWEVER, OTHER INFORMATION INDICATED THAT THE KILLER WAS NOT KIM, BUT ((CHA)) CHI CHOL, PRESIDENTIAL SECURITY FORCE CHIEF (UNCONFIRMED). THE SHOOTING ALLEGEDLY TOOK PLACE DURING A HEATED ARGUMENT BETWEEN KIM AND CHA CHI-CHOL, AN ARGUMENT WHICH PRESIDENT PARK WAS ALLEGEDLY ATTEMPTING TO STOP.

B. ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ THE REPUBLIC OF KOREA HAS BEEN PLACED UNDER MARTIAL LAW WITH THE ARMY CHIEF OF STAFF BEING PLACED IN COMMAND AS MARTIAL LAW ADMINISTRATOR. MILITARY SECURITY HAS BEEN PROVIDED FOR GOVERNMENT BUILDINGS IN SEOUL, AND ARMORED VEHICLES HAVE BEEN POSITIONED AROUND THE GENERAL AREA OF THE BLUE HOUSE. KOREAN SPECIAL FORCES ELEMENTS HAVE TAKEN OVER SECURITY AT MND AND ACCESS HAS BEEN RESTRICTED, BUT OTHERWISE, MND APPEARS QUIET. TWO ELEMENTS OF THE KOREAN SPECIAL FORCES PLACED ON DUTY IN PUSAN, KS, DUE TO PAST DISTURBANCES THERE, HAVE BEEN RETURNED TO SEOUL FOR SECURITY PURPOSES. EVEN UNDER THE IMPOSITION OF MARTIAL LAW, THE CITY STREETS IN SEOUL APPEAR TO HAVE THE NORMAL SATURDAY MORNING TRAFFIC. HOWEVER, IT SHOULD BE

POINTED OUT THAT THE NEWS HAS BEEN BROADCASTING ON KOREAN RADIO FOR ONLY A FEW HOURS AND PUBLIC REACTION IS NOT READILY APPARENT AT THIS TIME.

- C. ~~(S/NOFORN)~~ COMUS KOREA HAS ORDERED FORCES INTO "DEFENSE CONDITION 3" AS OF 262046Z OCT 79.

- D. (U) TRANSITION OF POWER IS TO THE PRIME MINISTER, ((CHOI)) KYU HA. HOWEVER, KDREAN LAW REQUIRES THE NATIONAL COMMITTEE FOR UNIFICATION (NOW NUMBERING ABOUT 3,000 PERSONS OF WHICH THE PRIME MINISTER IS MEMBER) TO ELECT A NEW PRESIDENT WITHIN 90 DAYS.

- E. ~~(S)~~ THE PRIME MINISTER HAS BEEN DESCRIBED AS AN EDUCATOR (FORMER COLLEGE PROFESSOR) WITHOUT ANY MAJOR MILITARY BACKGROUND, AND AS AN INDIVIDUAL WHO IS CONFUCIAN IN THOUGHT AND MANNER - NOT WESTERNIZED.

- F. (U) AT 1000 HOURS (LOCAL), 27 OCT 79, THE CHIEFS OF STAFF, KDREAN ARMED FORCES, EXPRESSED THEIR CONDOLENCES TO THE PARK FAMILY AND STATED THEIR SUPPORT FOR THE GOVERNMENT/PRIME MINISTER AND ASKED THE PUBLIC TO WORK WITHIN THE CONFINES OF THE INSTITUTED MARTIAL LAW.
