8. - (G/HF)- UN SECRETARY-GENERAL PEREZ DE CUELLAR TOLD REPORTERS IN PARIS ON THE 17TH THAT TRACE AUTHORITIES SHOULD BE CONTACTED PRIOR TO THE DEPLOYMENT OF FOREIGN MILITARY PERSONNEL IN IRAQ.
