- (U) NAME: Air Vice Marshal Soekardi, Indonesian Air Force. Variant Sukardi (pronounced soo-KAR-dee).
- (U) <u>POSITION</u>: Commander, National Strategic Command (KOSTRANAS), since April 1981.

(C/NOFORN) SIGNIFICANCE: Marshal Soekardi is a highly intelligent and professional officer who was once President Suharto's personal pilot. A forceful leader, he previously held the post of Deputy Commander, Regional Defense Command II, the most No photo available important territorial command, responsible for Java, Bali, the Lesser Sunda Islands and Timor. His present command, KOSTRANAS is the Joint Force Strike Headquarters which functions as a general reserve for the regional commands, develops training and operational doctrine, engages in strategic planning, and oversees the yearly combined force exercises. Although generally inactive in the past, KOSTRANAS, in recent years, has received increased attention as a result of Defense Minister General Jusuf's drive to upgrade military readiness. Marshal Soekardi may have accompanied Jusuf to the US, at least partially, to obtain new ideas for improving KOSTRANAS, possibly through comparison with the US Rapid Deployment Force. With retirement scheduled for 1985, this may be Soekardi's last military command.
