Subject: IRAQ PRISON				
What was said:				
Met with who related that was deployed to IRAQ between where worked as a counter-terrorism analyst at the inlet fusion center located on Camp Slayer. stated visited the Brigade Interrogation Facility (BIF) during the early part of Jan 04. The purpose of visit was to assist in an interrogation of a detainee suspected of making bombs. In ddition to there was a interrogator, a and a interrogator. stated that during the interrogation, there was no touching of the detainee, by any of the interrogators, nor was there any rough treatment of the detainee. by any of the interrogators, nor was there any rough treatment of the detainee. stated did notice that the detainee had bruises under both of his eyes, and that the bruises did not appear to be fresh. stated they were not the first group to interrogate the detainee, as the detainee knew the procedures of the interrogation. stated did not visit the Abu Ghraib prison during time in Iraq. stated did have multiple telephone conversations with the interrogators who worked at the Abu Ghraib prison, and during those conversations there were never any discussions of the activities that were going on at that prison. stated heard rumors of the detainees being subjected to sleep derivation, and the use of dogs to instill fear in the detainees, but has no first hand knowledge of those incidents. provided no additional information concerning either prison facility.
