2. (CONOFORN) SEVEN CUBANS IN A TAXICAB REACHED THE EMBASSY GROUNDS; SIX OF THE YOUTHS WERE SUCCESSFUL IN GAINING ADMISSION TO THE MAIN BUILDING, ALTHOUGH ONE WAS WOUNDED BY GUN-
