FOR CHINA: (2)(A) REINFORCING HER REGIONAL POWER AND HER INFLUENCE IN THE REGION TO BALANCE SOVIET INFLUENCE. OBTAINING WAR INVESTMENTS AND ECONOMIC PROJECTS SUPPORT THE CHINESE ECONOMY. (c)ENSURING A CHINESE PRESENCE FOR MAINTENANCE AND TRAINING ON THE NEW ARMS.
