THE NPA PROBABLY DOES NOT HAVE THE CAPABILITY TO MOUNT ANY LARGE SCALE MORTAR ATTACKS, BUT PC OFFICERS HAVE MENTIONED NPA TRAINING WITH MORTAR OCCURRING IN CENTRAL LUZON, AND THE NPA HAS BEEN KNOWN TO USE MORTARS IN ISOLATED ATTACKS AGAINST THE AFP.
