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3. (c) During the afternoon tour of 8th Division facilities, and later on during an informal evening discussion, sources cited a series of events in the Santa Cruz area which suggest links with subversive elements outside BOLIVIA. a. Distribution of an illustrated leaflet, of which source showed published by the "VANGUARDIA ANTI-IMPERIALISTA DEL ORIENTE", attack a copy.

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published by the "VANGUARDIA ANTI-IMPERIALISTA DEL ORIENTE", attacking Banzer's dictatorship" and showing photographs of ALLIDES and FELIX SANDOVAL MORON, two brothers who were "martyrs" of the Banzer government. COMMENT: The Sandoval family was famed during the TURRES era as a ruthless group of local "warlords" in the Santa Cruz area. With Banzer's advent to power in 1971, they slipped out of BOLIVIA and established their new base in Salta, in Northern ARGENTINA.

b. The increasing appearance on walls in Santa Cruz of such slogans hostile to Banzer as "Banzer-Nepotism", or "Banzer = hambre." This, as well as inflamatory antigovernment leaflets, have been published, according to sources, MIR (Movimiento Izquierdista Revolucionario) elements now operating out of Buenos Aires. The MIR, according to sources, is increasingly receiving support from the Argentine ERP (Ejercito Revolucionario del Pueblo), and may use this support to stimulate anti-Banzer activities in BOLIVIA.

c. The publication in the Santa Cruz area of a Leftist interpretation of current events in Latin America, entitled "Situacion de los Movimientos en America Latina", which were reportedly provided to source by a priest. The document states among other things that TORRES failed because he did not hand over complete power to the People's Assembly.

d. The suspicious movements between Santa Cruz and ARGENTINA of a Bolivian Leftist named ARAUS, who reportedly has brought dissident elements into the Santa Cruz area to provoke trouble.

c. Evidence that UCAPO (Union de Compesinos Pobres) elements, although currently quiet, are preparing for future activity. From a source within UCAPO. 8th Division elements reportedly obtained recently a list of 30 local members, which he forwarded to La Paz.

f. Suspicious activities in early January 1976 in the GRETER (Coords: 6030W-1610S ) area of 16 (fourteen) armed clements. As a result, the Bolivian Air Force provided a helicopter so that 12th Infantry "Manchego" Regiment commander Lt Colonel MARISCAL together with several men, could rake a reconnaissance of the area. The o January reconnaisance, which included ground landings and dicussions with local campesines, Gid not yield any positive information. Movever, the campesines agreed to furnish information in the future in the event of any suspicious activities. COMMENT: Sources indicated that they believed that in this particular case the "armed men" were probably hunters, tracking down animals for their skins . However, both officers agreed that the area would serve as an excellent zone for guerilla operations).

SRF COMMENTS. Bolivia has its own MIR, patterned after that in Chile, and consisting of about 40 members. Although not certain, it appears that the above-mentioned propagenda was put out by the local Bolivian MIR, based upon international contacts.

SKF has no specific traces on ARAUS; a certain Luis ARAOZ T. was a recipient of Chicom propaganda in the early 1970's, and there are records for several other ARAOZ and a few ARAUS; however, the latter seemed to be left wing members of the MNR .
