
ARGENTINE TERRORIST ACTIVITIES

On May 8, 1978, a source

reported the

following information:

Information has been received that six groups of specially-trained terrorists will travel to Argentina prior to the commencement of the June, 1978 World Cup soccer match in order to carry out acts of terrorism. The source reported that the six terrorist groups were composed of several highly trained individuals and that they had received training in Europe. Source reported that it was believed that two of the groups had already clandestinely entered Argentina.
