. THE PRESIDENT OF COPECODECA, COL
CESAR RAMON ((QUINTERAS)) ALVARADO FELT THAT THE
US SHOULD PROVIDE MORE AID TO HIS ORGANIZATION
AND CENTRAL AMERICA. IN ADDITION, IT IS HARDER FOR
HIS ORGANIZATION TO LEGALLY SUPPORT THE US POSITION
IN CENTRAL AMERICA, DUE TO US SUPPORT OF THE CONTRAS.

PROBLEMS.)
