

SECURITY COMMITTEE //ISDSC// OF SADC. DURING THE MEETING THE CHAIR OF THE ISDSC TRANSFERRED FROM SWAZILAND TO MOZAMBIQUE. KEY ISSUES ON CRIME, OF CROSS BORDERAND REGIONAL IMPORTANCE, WERE DISCUSSED IN THE AREAS OF DRUG TRAFFICKING, CAR THEFT, AND ILLEGAL IMMIGRATION. THE CONFLICTS IN ANGOLA AND THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO WERE MAIN POINTS CONSIDERED DURING THE MEETING, AS WELL AS THE PROPOSED PROTOCOL REVISING THE ORGAN FOR POLITICS, DIPLOMACY, AND SECURITY. PRESIDENT CHISSANO TOOK THE OPPORTUNITY TO ONCE AGAIN THANK SADC MILITARY ESTABLISHMENTS FOR THEIR ASSISTANCE DURING THE FEBRUARY AND MARCH FLOODING IN MOZAMBIQUE AND HIGHLIGHTED THE NEEDFOR A MECHANISM WITHIN SADC FOR MANAGING AND PREVENTING DISASTERS IN THE REGION. THE ISDSC MEETING TOOK PLACE AT THE ((ROVUM A)) HOTEL IN DOWNTOWN MAPUTO. 12 OF THE 14 SADC MEMBER STATES WERE PRESENT. REPRESENTATIVES OF THE DEMOCRATIC REPUBLIC OF THE CONGO AND THE SEYCHELLES DID NOT ATTEND.

IN HIS REMARKS, PRESIDENT CHISSANO URGED THE APPROVAL OF THE PROTOCOL REVISING THE FUNCTIONING OF

WHEN ADOPTED, THE PROTOCOL WILL MAKE THE CHAIR OF THE OPDS THE RESIDING PRESIDENT OF SADC, WHO WOULD THEN CONSULT WITH FORMER AND FUTURE PRESIDENTS OF SADC ON DECISIONS RELATED TO POLITICS, DIPLOMACY, AND SECURITY. THIS ARRANGEMENT OF A TROIKA OF DECISION MAKERS AVAILABLE FOR CONSULTATION BRINGS UNITY TOTHE PROCESS AND WILL EFFECTIVELY AVOID FUTURE CONFLICTS IN POLICY DECISIONS WITHIN SADC, SUCH AS THOSE FORMERLY EXPERIENCED BY ROBERT ((MUGABE)) AND NELSON ((MANDELA)). THE PRESIDENT OF ZIMBABWE, ROBERT MUGABE, WAS THE CHAIRMAN OF THE OPDS AND DISAGREED WITH THE PRESIDENT OF SOUTH AFRICA, NELSON MANDELA, WHO WAS THE PRESIDENT OF SADC.
