SUMMARY: (U) SOUTH AFRICA IS WITHIN MONTHS OF SIGNING MAJOR ARMS SALES CONTRACTS WITH MALAYSIA. ARTILLERY, UAV'S, AND THE 'ROOIVALK' ATTACK HELICOPTER ARE INCLUDED.

TEXT: 1. (U) SOURCE ARTICLE REPORTS THAT MALAYSIA WISHES TO PURCHASE 22 'G-5' ARTILLERY SYSTEMS, AS WELL AS KENTRON'S 'SEEKER' UNMANNED AERIAL VEHICLE. ADDITIONALLY, THE MALAYSIAN MINISTRY OF DEFENSE HAS "SHOWN AN INTEREST IN THE 'ROOIKAT' COMBAT VEHICLE MANUFACTURED BY VICKERS-OMC".

[redacted] MALAYSIAHAS INDICATED THAT IT IS CONSIDERING PLACING THE 'ROOIVALK' ATTACK HELICOPTER BACK ON ITS ACQUISITION PROGRAM. THE PURCHASE OF EIGHT ROOIVALK'S IS BELIEVED TO BE INCLUDED IN THE MALAYSIAN GOVERNMENT'S PROCUREMENT PLAN FOR THE NEXT FIVE YEARS.
