SUMMARY: (U) [REDACTED] (C) DESPITE CHISSANO-MANDELA ACCORD, FADM COMMANDER LTG LAGOS BLOCKS THE FIRST JOINT MOZAMBIQUE POLICE-SANDF CROSS-BORDER OPERATION TO CLEAR AN ARMS CACHE. LAGOS CLAIMS ESTIMATED 10 TONS OF MUNITIONS BELONG TO THE FADM. PRETORIA SUSPECTS HANDPRINTS OF GOV'T OFFICERS AND HALTS ALL COOPERATION. MANY OTHER CACHES ALSO EXIST ALONG THE BORDER, MOSTLY RENAMO.

[REDACTED] AFTER MONTHS OF DISCUSSION, PLANNING, COORDINATION, AND HIGH-LEVEL APPROVAL, THE MOZAMBIKAN IMMIGRATION POLICE AND THE SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENSE FORCE (SANDF) WERE SCHEDULED TO LAUNCH THE FIRST JOINT ARMS CLEARING OPERATION IN EARLY JUNE 95 AT AN ABANDONED PORTUGUESE ARMY AND MOZAMBIKAN ARMED FORCES (FAM) MILITARY AMMUNITION BASE AT MABALANE

[REDACTED] ABOUT 190 KILOMETERS NORTH OF RESSANO GARCIA AND LOCATED NEAR THE SOUTH AFRICAN BORDER. THE OPERATION INCLUDED ABOUT 20 MOZAMBIKAN IMMIGRATION POLICE AND SIX (6) SANDF SOLDIERS AND WAS DESIGNED TO CLEAR AN ESTIMATED 10 TONS OF WEAPONS, MINES, AND MUNITIONS FROM A KNOWN ARMS CACHE SITE. (b)(1) [REDACTED] THE SANDF HAD TRACED ACTIVE LARGE-SCALE ARMS SMUGGLING FROM THIS SITE OVER THE PAST 12 MONTHS.

(C) ON THE EVE OF THE OPERATION, HOWEVER, THE CHIEF OF STAFF OF THE MOZAMBICAN ARMED DEFENSE FORCES (FADM), LIEUTENANT GENERAL ((LAGOS)) LIDIMO, BLOCKED THE ACTION AND PROHIBITED EXTRACTION OF ALL MUNITIONS FROM THE SITE. LTG LAGOS REPORTEDLY TOLD THE IMMIGRATION POLICE THAT THE BASE BELONGS TO THE FADM AND THAT NO MUNITIONS CAN BE EXTRACTED WITHOUT FADM APPROVAL. SOURCE A NOTED THAT LTG LAGOS LIKELY HAS NO INTENTION OF PERMITTING ANYONE BUT THE FADM TO CLEAR THE ARMS CACHE SITE.

3. (C) [REDACTED] THE SOUTH AFRICAN GOVERNMENT REACTED WITH CONSIDERABLE CONSTERNATION AND THEN DIRECTED THE AMBASSADOR TO INTERVENE WITH THE MOZAMBICAN DEFENSE MINISTER, MR AGUIAR MAZULA. OVER OVER THE PAST TWO WEEKS, HOWEVER, THE SOUTH AFRICAN AMBASSADOR HAS BEEN UNABLE TO GET IN TO SEE MR MAZULA. SINCE LAGOS' DECISION, ALL BORDER COOPERATION HAS HALTED.
