TEXT: 1. (S/NF/WN) SOUTH AFRICA'S UNITY MOVEMENT BELIEVES THE SOLUTION TO THE CURRENT CRISIS IN SOUTH AFRICA LIES IN THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A CONFEDERATION OF NINE DISTINCT NATION STATES, "BOERE-AFRIKANERLAND" TO REPLACE WHAT IS CURRENTLY SOUTH AFRICA.

DIVISION OF THE COUNTRY INTO THE NINE NATION STATES IS BASED UPON THE EXISTENCE OF DISTINCT ETHNIC, LINGUISTIC AND CULTURAL GROUPS PRESENTLY WITHIN SOUTH AFRICA. UNDER THE CONFEDERATION, EACH STATE

WOULD DETERMINE ITS OWN FORM OF GOVERNMENT, BE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE

DEFENSE, EDUCATION AND HEALTH OF ITS PEOPL E, CREATE ITS OWN CONSTITUTION, DEVELOP A SYSTEM OF TAXATION, AND CREATE ITS OWN SECURITY/DEFENSE FORCE' UNDER THIS SYSTEM, REGIONAL AUTONOMY WOULD

EXCEED FEDERAL AUTHORITY, WITH THE VAST MAJORITY OF POWER IN THE HANDS OF THE NATION STATES' A CENTRAL AUTHORITY WOULD BE RESPONSIBLE FOR FOREIGN AFFAIRS, REGIONAL COOPERATION AND SOCIAL AND
