- SECTION 84 OF 86 (b)(3) 10 U.S.C 424 CHITTAGONG 15. THE MUJAHIDEEN CPYRATE APPROXIMATELY THREE CAMPS ALONG THE BANGLADESH-MYANMAR BORDER (PROBABLY JUST INSIDE MYANMAR. BUT IT'S HARD TO SAY). HAM PREFER A HILL MASS THAT BUNS HORTHWEST TO SOUTHEAST NORTHWEST EDGE APPROXIMATELY (b)(3) 10 U.S.C 424 . SOUTHWEST EDGE (b)(3) 10 U.S.C AT LEAST TWO CAMPS ARE IN THE HILL 424 MASS ALONG THE NORTH-SOUTH BORDER. AN ADDITIONAL SMALLER CAMP MAY BE AT APPROXIMATELY (b)(3) 10 U.S.C (b)(3) 10 U.S.C, NEAR THE BORDER. 424 (c) RSO SAYS THEY HAVE 620 REGULARS AND HAVE TRAINED MANY MORE WHO HAVE RETURNED TO THEIR VILLAGES. PHOTOS OF AN APPROXIMATELY 150 MAN UNIT WERE SEEN BY SOURCE E. THE RSO MAY WEAR BANGLADESH STYLE CAMOUPLAGED CAPS (BOUGHT IN THE MARKET SAYS RSO) AND OLIVE-GRAY DRAB FATIGUES WITH A PISTOL THE UNIFORM LOOKS MORE LIKE A MYANMAR ARMY FIELD UNIFORM THAN A BANGLADESH FIELD UNIFORM. (b)(3):10 USC 424 (D) THE RSOM ARE ARMEI WITH A MENAGERIE OF WEAPONS. SOURCE SAY MANY AK47/AKM STYLE 7.62MM SMGS - FIXED AND FOLDING STOCK. THE NEXT MOST NUMEROUS WEAPON IS THE MIG AND ARARTHE G3. ALSO NOTED WERE M1 CARBINES, AN FN OR TWO. TYPE 56/SKS-STYLY RIPLES. RPG? LAUNCHERS AND AT LEAST TWO MES LAWS (WHICH LOOKED EXPENDED) (FIELD COMMENT - A RECENT LIR HAD COMMENTED THAT LAYS MIGHT BE BEING SOLD TO THE RSO BY PAKISTAN). ALSO NOTED WERE TWO MACHINE GUNS, PROBABLY SOVIET STYLE 7.62 MM MACHINE GUAS. MANY OF THE SAME GROUPS OF WEAPONS WERE SHOWN BEING HANDLET BY DIFFERENT MUJ. $(b)(6)_{-}$ THAT THEY BOUGHT OR STOLE MOST 18. titiet. OF THE WEAPONS IN MYANMAR. HE SAID SOME WERE ALSO BROUGHT IN PROM SOUTHEAST ASIA. SOURCE F INDICATED WHIMP MAKY WERE OBTAINED IN THAILAND. THE WEAPONS LOOKED MAINTAINED. THOUGH NOT WELL MAINTAINED. (b)(6)19. THAT THE MYANMAR SECURITY FORCES HAD NOT YET SOUGHT OUT ROBINGYA SOLIDARITY ORGANIZATION TRAINING CAMPS. HE ALSO SAID THE RSO MUSLIMS HAD NOT SALLIED FORTH YET TO CHALLENGE THE SECURITY FORCES. HE COMPLAINED THAT BORDER OUTPOSTS WERE BEING REINFORCED AND THAT THE RELATIVELY NEW CANTONMENT FOR 2,500-3,000 SOLDIERS, SIX MILES TO THE WEST OF BUTHILGUNG. APPROX [(b)(3) 10 U.S.C 424 . HAD BECOME QUITE ACTIVE IN HARASSING/TORTURING/RAPING ROHINGYA MUSLIMS IN THE THE ACTIVITY OF THE BUTHIDGUNG BRIGADE WAS SAID TO HAVE PROMPTED THE MOST RECENT MIGRATION. EXAMPLES INCLUDE A UNIT (55 INFANTRY REGIMENT?) WAS SAID TO BE ACTIVE IN LATE DECEMBER 90, OPENING A CAMP IN IRZALIPARA UNDER MAUNGDOW TOWNSHIP. SOTH INFANTRY REGIMENT STATIONET AT FERUNPU OUTPOST.
