The enemy utilized different means to carry out attacks, such as exploiting security gaps, infiltrating men into the **Afghan** National Army (ANA) and **Afghan** National Police (ANP) aimed at attacking **Afghan** and international forces, placing road side Improvised Explosive Devices (IEDs), setting ambushes, and other conventional tactics in order to demonstrate the weak capability of security forces. Based on such actions, they aim to achieve their goals and create mistrust among the **Afghan** National Security Forces (ANSF) and International forces.
