1. (O) PRESIDENT MOBUTU IS REPORTEDLY UNHAPPY WITH AT LEAST TWO SENIOR ARMED FORCES LEADERS AND MAY MAKE CHANGES SOON. 2. (C) GEN MAHELE, HEAD OF MILITARY INTELLIGENCE AND OFFICER-IN-CHARGE DURING THE EMBARRASSING PERFORMANCE BY THE SPECIAL PRESIDENTIAL DIVISION WHEN IT OPERATED IN **RWANDA** RECENTLY, HAS REPORTEDLY FALLEN INTO DISFAVOR WITH THE PRESIDENT. MAHELE REPORTEDLY POCKETED MOST OF THE MONEY DESIGNATED FOR THE **RWANDA** OPERATIONS; FAILED TO PROV1DE PLANNING, COMMAND, OR OPERATIONAL GUIDANCE TO ZAIRIAN UNITS DURING THE DEPLOYMENT; AND ARGUED SUCCESSFULLY AGA1NST THE PARTICIPATION OF MOBUTU'S NEPHEW.
