SUMMARY: ~~(S/NF)~~ IN EARLY NOVEMBER 2001, SOUTH AFRICA DEPLOYED A PEACEKEEPING UNIT TO BURUNDI TO PROTECT POLITICAL OFFICIALS. THE MOVE IS VIEWED AS NECESSARY BY SOME SOUTH AFRICAN OFFICIALS TO SLOWLY INCREASE ITS INVOLVEMENT IN PEACEKEEPING OPERATIONS ON THE CONTINENT. SOUTH AFRICA IS EXPECTED TO PLAY A LARGER ROLE THAN IT HAS IN THE PAST.
