SOURCE NOTED THESE STATES WERE CHOSEN BECAUSE THEY ARE TAX-FREE HAVENS. ACCORDING TO SOURCE, THE MILITARY OFFICERS HOPE MOVING THEI MONEY TO BANKS IN THE EAST WOULD NEUTRALIZE THE CURRENT EFFORTS BEING SPEARHEADED BY SOUTH AFRICAN PRESIDENT NELSON ((MANDELA)).
