
Thank you for taking time to observe the operations of Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) personnel supporting OPERATION SEVENTH FLAG along the U.S. border with Mexico and for visiting the DIA Defense Intelligence Capabilities Fair on Capitol Hill.

You may be interested to know that the DIA Directorate for MASINT and Technical Collection (DT) provides actionable intelligence in support of federal law enforcement counterterrorism and counternarcotics efforts. A major objective of this partnership is to expose federal law enforcement personnel to valuable technical collection technologies, and proven tactics, techniques, and procedures learned on the battlefield. DIA supports efforts to expand federal law enforcement border-monitoring capabilities while building a mutually beneficial and enduring relationship. Since 2006, this collaboration led to the seizure of over \$8 million in illegal drugs and the apprehension of numerous special-interest aliens. During OPERATION SEVENTH FLAG, DIA efforts yielded nearly \$500,000 worth of narcotics and detected nearly 500 illegal entry attempts.
