THE THIRD THIS YEAR -- FROM THE USSR. THE SOVIET FREIGHTER AKADEMIK SHIMANSKIY IS EXPECTED TO ARRIVE IN THE HAVANA/MARIEL AREA SHORTLY WITH 4,400 TONS OF MILITARY EQUIPMENT INCLUDING FIGHTER AIRCRAFT CRATES.
