THE DANISH AIR FORCE PLANNERS ARE NOW PREPARING A PURCHASE OF NEW FIGHTER AIRPLANES WORTH A TOTAL AMOUNT SOMEWHERE BETWEEN 3.2 AND ALMOST TEN BILLION KRONER.
THEY ARE ALREADY FAR AHEAD WITH THE PLANS FOR REPLACEMENT OF THE TWO AIR FORCE SQUADRONS WITH A TOTAL OF 32 DRAKEN AIRPLANES WHICH ARE TO BE DECOMMISSIONED DURING THE COMING YEARS.

- IT WILL BE A POLITICAL DECISION WHETHER A SIMILAR NUMBER OF AIRPLANES WILL BE NEEDED OR WHETHER IT WILL BE ENOUGH TO GET FOR INSTANCE HALF THE ORIGINAL NUMBER. THE POLITICAL DECISION ON THIS IS EXPECTED TO BE MADE AFTER THE DEFENSE COMMISSION HAS SUBMITTED ITS REPORT AT NEXT TURN OF THE YEAR ABOUT THE FUTURE DEFENSE STRUCTURE.

- A SMALLER NUMBER OF AIRPLANES WILL BE ENOUGH IF IT IS DECIDED THAT THE DANISH AIR FORCE SHOULD ONLY --IN CONNECTION WITH THE NATO COOPERATION -- CONCENTRATE ON DOWNING OF AIRPLANES THAT ATTACK DENMARK, AND THAT THE PARTNERS IN NATO SHOULD THEN CARRY OUT THE MORE DIRECT ATTACKS ON THE MILITARY TARGETS IN THE ATTACKING EASTERN COUNTRIES.

-THE AIR FORCE SHOULD ALSO TAKE INTO CONSIDERATION THAT THERE ARE NOT FIGHTER PILOTS ENOUGH TO MAN ALL THE AIRPLANES. THIS IS AN IMPORTANT ARGUMENT WHICH SHOULD PUT A DAMPER ON THE DESIRE TO GET 100 PERCENT REPLACEMEN FOR THE OLD DRAKEN AIRPLANES.

- THE AIR FORCE HAD A MAJOR PURCHASE OF FIGHTER PLANES IN THE MID-SEVENTIES WHEN DENMARK -- AS PART OF THE "ARMS DEAL OF THE CENTURY" -- BOUGHT 58 F-16 PLANES. THEY WERE SUPPLEMENTED WITH 12 F-16'S NINE YEARS LATER. - THE PRICE OF THE F-16 AIRPLANES FOR THE DANISH GOVERNMANT -- AND THEREBY FOR THE DANISH TAXPAYERS --WAS THE TIDY SUM OF 5.2 BILLION KRONER. TWICE AS MUCH AS HAD BEEN ESTIMATED AT THE BEGINNING.

IN ITS EXPLORING OF THE AIRPLANE MARKET, THE AIR
FORCE HAS CONFINED ITSELF TO TWO POSSIBILITIES: THE

3. (U) ON 890720 IT WAS REPORTED THAT NEGOTIATIONS SHOULD BEGIN IN 1990 ON A CONTRACT TO REPLACE THE DRAKEN. THERE ARE TWO 16 UE DRAKEN SQUADRONS IN THE RDAF THUS THE REFERENCE TO 32 AIRCRAFT. THE JULY BOERSEN ARTICLE CORRECTLY STATED ALSO THAT THE 32 AIRCRAFT MIGHT ACTUALLY BE AS MANY AS 48 AIRCRAFT. THE RDAF CURRENTLY HAS 44 DRAKENS EQUIPING THE TWO 16 UE SQUADRONS.
