3. (U) AT THE AWARD CEREMONY FOR GEN BALZA, THE BRAZILIAN AMBASSADOR TO ARGENTINA COMMENTED THAT RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO MILITARIES AS WELL AS THE TWO COUNTRIES WERE EXCELLENT. HE ALSO COMMENTED THAT AS A CAREER DIPLOMAT, HE COULD ASK FOR NO BETTER ASSIGNMENT THAN TO BE IN BUENOS AIRES AT THIS TIME OF OUTSTANDING RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. IN THEIR REMARKS. BOTH GEN ZOROASTRO AND GEN BALZA ALSO CHARACTERIZED THE RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO ARMIES AS THE BEST EVER. IN ADDITION TO THE MINISTER OF DEFENSE, ALSO PRESENT AT THE BRAZILIAN EMBASSY IN BUENOS AIRES FOR THE PRESENTATION OF THE AWARD TO GEN BALZA WERE THE CHIEF OF THE JOINT STAFF, THE CHIEFS OF THE ARMY AND NAVY, AS WELL AS NUMEROUS MEMBERS OF THE DIPLOMATIC CORPS. MILITARY ATTACHES AND GOVERNMENT OFFICIALS. 4. (U) TO DEMONSTRATE THE DEGREE OF CLOSENESS THE ARMIES HAVE REACHED, AT AN EARLIER CEREMONY ON 940829 IN GUALEGUAYCHU, THE ARGARM NAMED ITS 12TH TANK REGIMENT AFTER A BRAZILIAN WAR HERO. THIS IS THE FIRST TIME THAT AN ARGARM UNIT HAS CARRIED THE HISTORIC NAME

OF A HERO FROM ANOTHER COUNTRY.
