- THE MODERNIZATION PROCESS EXPLAINED THE METHODOLOGY USED TO DEVELOP THE PROSPECTIVE SCENARIO, ESTABLISHING THE FUTURE MISSIONS FOR THE ARGARM, AND EVALUATION OF THE MODEL CALLED THE VERIFICATION PHASE AND THE FINAL PHASE THE APPROVAL PLAN.
- THE CONCEPT DEVELOPMENT DEFINED THE NEEDS OF THE ARGARM AND THE NEW OPERATIONAL ARGARM ORGANIZATION.
- CORRECTION OF DEFICIENCIES IDENTIFIED EXISTING
 DEFICIENCIES IN THE AREAS OF PERSONNEL, OPERATIONS,
 EDUCATION, LOGISTICS AND FINANCE AND PROVIDED
 GENERALIZED SOLUTIONS TO CORRECT THE PROBLEM.

THE BRIEFING

LASTED APPROXIMATELY 60 MINUTES AND WAS EXTREMELY OPEN AND FRANK AS WERE THE DISCUSSIONS THAT FOLLOWED IT. GEN BALZA ADMITTED THAT PAST MILITARY DICTATORSHIPS WERE A DEFINITE MISTAKE AND NOW THE LESSONS LEARNED SHOULD BE APPLIED TO PRODUCE A BETTER ARGARM.

- 2. (C) ALTHOUGH THE RESTRUCTURING PLAN TAKES INTO ACCOUNT THE ACCOMPLISHING OF EACH PHASE UNDER CONDITIONS OF FINANCIAL HARDSHIP, THE ECONOMIC REALITY (MORE SEVERE THAN THE PROJECTED ONE) IS MAKING IT VERY HARD FOR THE ARGARM TO PUT THEIR PLAN INTO ACTION.
- 3. (A) THE SUCCESS OF THIS PLAN WILL SHAPE THE FUTURE ARGARM. IF SUCCESSFUL ARGENTINA MAY HAVE A PROFESSIONAL ARMY TO MEET TOMORROW'S CHALLENGES, IF IT FAILS, THE PRESENT UNSTABLE SITUATION WILL CONTINUE AND MAY SERIOUSLY AFFECT THE FUTURE ARGARM AS CAPABLE OFFICERS MAY BECOME DESILLUSIONED AND LEAVE THE

SERVICE.
