22. DETAILS: (S) This IR forwards a wrap-up of terrorist activity for the month of February. It is being sent through DIA Channel to ensure receipt and dissemination.

COMMENT: (C) Although tallies have not been completed for March and April, it appears that there has been a substantial increase in terrorist activities over those of February. It is apparent that the Montoneros are gearing up for the 1980 World Cup Games and we can expect more incidents in the weeks to come

- It was also reported that a few days earlier a group of persons had fired shots at and attempted to burn the Chevy auto agency owned by Francisco P. Melano in Merlo. One vehicle was burned and the guard, Umberto Giles, was ~~badlyxxxxxx~~ injured.

- Two armed persons attacked Cpl. Nicasio Luna of Federal Police Precinct 8 while on duty at the Reconquista ~~bridge~~ bridge, Rivera and Cordoba Sts. in Moreno. They stole his weapon and credentials.

- On the same date, Federal Police Inspector Osvaldo Cannizzano heard a loud explosion near his residence and observed a wounded person running from the scene. He followed the blood track until he reached a residence at Faimallá 758, where he found Daniel Guillermo Villar seriously wounded. Villar was taken to a hospital where he died. The house at Faimallá (La Plata) contained a destroyed transistor radio and Montonero documents.

- FEB 16: Four persons in a pickup truck attacked the home of Defense Minister José María Klix located at Valle 1049, Buenos Aires. As a result of this attack a civilian and a Federal Police agent were wounded and there was a damage to the front of the Klix residence.

The attackers fled, deserting the attack vehicle severely
