22. DETAILS: (U) On 19 January 1978 a young prison official was machine gunned to death as he travelled from his home to his work at the Women's Correctional Institute. The official, Alberto Buzarquiz, was intercepted by two cars and shot with several heavy caliber weapons. According to official reports, the terrorists shot Buzarquiz once at point blank range to insure that he had been killed before they made their escape.

COMMENTS: ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ Official accounts of the killing do not identify the subversive group that is responsible for the killing. This death demonstrates that the cells of terrorists that remain active are still capable of planning and carrying out kill and run maneuvers. This type of subversive action will serve to reinforce the position of those in the GOA who emphasize the need for continuing the active campaign against terrorists despite the excesses which might occur in executing that campaign.
