16. SUMMARY: 1. ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ ARGENTINE NAVY CONTINUES TO TAKE ACTION AGAINST FOREIGN FISHING VESSELS WHICH THEY CLAIM ARE VIOLATING ARGENTINE NATIONAL TERRITORY BY FISHING WITHIN 200 NAUTICAL MILES OF ARGENTINE COAST.

22. DETAILS: 1. ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ AS REPORTED IN IR (b)(3):10 USC 424 FOUR RUSSIAN FISHING SHIPS WERE RECENTLY CAPTURED AND TAKEN TO PORT. SUBSEQUENTLY, THE ARA DESTROYER ROSALES CAPTURED A FIFTH RUSSIAN SHIP, A FISH PROCESSING AND TRANSPORT ("FACTORY") SHIP, CALLED NEREY. ALL SHIPS WERE TAKEN TO PUERTO MADRYN (COORDINATES: 4248S - 6503W) TO AWAIT ASSESSMENT OF FINES AND CONFISCATION OF FISH THAT WAS FOUND ABOARD. FINES WILL BE ASSESSED BY THE ARGENTINE PREFECTURA (COAST GUARD) AND COULD RUN AS HIGH AS 100,000 U.S. PER SHIP. SOURCE A, Sec. 3.3(b) (1) STATED THAT THERE WERE AS MANY AS 12 TO 16 FISHING SHIPS LOCATED WITHIN ARGENTINE WATERS BUT MANY OF THEM ESCAPED. HE STATED THAT SOME OF THE SHIPS WERE FIRST SEEN ABOUT 80NM FROM THE ARGENTINA COASTLINE. ARGENTINA CLAIMS 200NM AS THEIR TERRITORIAL LIMIT. THE OTHER SHIPS CAPTURED INITIALLY (BESIDES THE FACTORY SHIP) ARE: BUSSOL, TEODOR NETTE, APATIT, MAGNIT. (TEODOR NETTE AND MAGNIT WERE MISSPELLED IN ORIGINAL REPORT.)

2. ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ ON 1 OCT THE ARGENTINE NAVY AGAIN TOOK AGGRESSIVE ACTION TO CAPTURE MORE FOREIGN VESSELS IN ARGENTINE WATERS. AT LEAST ONE BULGARIAN SAILOR WAS WOUNDED WHEN ARGENTINE NAVY SHIPS FIRED UPON AND HIT TWO BULGARIAN FISHING TRAWLERS. THE PREVIOUS CAPTURE OF FIVE SOVIET FISHING TRAWLERS DID NOT APPEAR TO INTIMIDATE THE FOREIGN FISHING FLEET AND LATE ON 1 OCT FOUR MORE VESSELS WERE CAPTURED AND UNDER ESCORT TO PUERTO MADRYN. THEY ARE: AURELIA (BULGARIAN), OFELIA (BULGARIAN), PROKOPYEVSKI (RUSSIAN), AND FRANZ HALE (RUSSIAN).

3. ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ THE HEAD OF THE NAVY'S PUBLIC INFORMATION DEPARTMENT SAID THAT THE CINC ARA, ADM MASSERA, HAD PERSONALLY SUPERVISED THE CAPTURE. HIS ORDERS TO THE ON-SCENE COMMANDER, ADM JORGE ANAYA, CDR NAVAL FORCES, WAS "IF NECESSARY, ACTION IS TO BE TAKEN AGAINST THE FOREIGN VESSELS TO THE ULTIMATE CONSEQUENCES TO DEFEND NATIONAL SOVEREIGNTY".

4. ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ THE ARGENTINE NAVY SHIPS FIRED UPON AND HIT THE "AURELIA" AND OFELIA WHICH WERE LOCATED ABOUT 90NM FROM COMODORO RIVADAVIA. WHEN THE CO OF THE ARA DESTROYER PIEDRA BUENA ORDERED THE BULGARIAN SHIP "AURELIA" TO GIVE ITSELF UP, THE BULGARIAN SHIP SPED AT FULL SPEED TOWARDS INTERNATIONAL WATERS. THREE SHOTS WERE FIRED UPON THE "AURELIA" BEFORE IT SURRENDERED TO THE ARGENTINE

NAVY. THE CAPTURE OF THE OFELIA TOOK PLACE UNDER SIMILAR CIRCUMSTANCES. UNFORTUNATELY, THREE ARGENTINE PETTY OFFICERS PERISHED IN THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF 1 OCTOBER. THEY WERE IN A LAUNCH WHICH CAPSIZED WHILE TRYING TO MAKE ITS WAY TO ONE OF THE RUSSIAN TRAWLERS. SOME REPORTS ACCUSE THE FISHING SHIPS OF FAILING TO PARTICIPATE IN THE SEARCH FOR THE THREE MISSING SAILORS AND, IN FACT, OF TAKING ADVANTAGE OF THE SITUATION BY TRYING TO ESCAPE DURING THE SEARCH OPERATION. AT THIS MOMENT THE CAPTURED SHIPS ARE AWAITING FINAL ACTION BY THE ARA.

COMMENT: ~~(C/NOFORN)~~ THE ARA HAS AN INADEQUATE PATROL FORCE TO SURVEIL THEIR CLAIMED 200NM TERRITORIAL WATERS. SOURCE B STATED THAT THE RUSSIANS KNOW THIS AND TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE SITUATION BY GOING CLOSE TO THE ARGENTINE COAST WHERE THERE IS AN ABUNDANCE OF FISH. SOURCE A STATED THAT AN ARA P2 WHO HAPPENED TO BE ON PATROL (AFTER HAVING BEEN TIPPED OFF BY LOCAL FISHERMEN) WAS THE FIRST TO SPOT THE ALLEGED VIOLATION. WITH A TOTAL OF FIVE P2 NAVY PATROL AIRCRAFT, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE ARA TO PROTECT ITS CLAIMED WATERS. DESPITE THESE DISADVANTAGES, THESE NAVAL ACTIVITIES COMBINE TO ENHANCE THE REPUTATION OF THE POLITICALLY AMBITIOUS CINC OF THE NAVY, ADMIRAL MASSERA. IN TAKING ON THE RUSSIANS HE BECOMES SOMETHING OF A NATIONAL HERO. RUSSIAN REACTION AT PRESENT HAS BEEN LOW. PHOTOGRAPHS WILL BE FORWARDED BY SEPARATE LETTER. THIS MSG COORD W/EMBASSY.
