NAVY. THE CAPTURE OF THE OFELIA TOOK PLACE UNDER SIMILAR CIRCUM—
STANCES. UNFORTUNATELY, THREE ARGENTINE PETTY OFFICERS PERISHED IN
THE EARLY MORNING HOURS OF 1 OCTOBER. THEY WERE IN A LAUNCH WHICH
CAPSIZED WHILE TRYING TO MAKE ITS WAY TO ONE OF THE RUSSIAN TRANSLESS
SOME REPORTS ACCUSE THE FISHING SHIPS OF FAILING TO PARTICIPATE IN
THE SEARCH FOR THE THREE MISSING SAILORS AND, IN FACT, OF TAKING
ADVANTAGE OF THE SITUATION BY TRYING TO ESCAPE DURING THE SEARCH
OPERATION. AT THIS MOMENT THE CAPTURED SHIPS ARE AWAITING
FINAL ACTION BY THE ARA.

COMMENT: (C/NOFORM) THE ARA HAS AN INADEQUATE PATROL FORCE TO SURVEIL THEIR CLAIMED 200NM TERRORITORAL WATERS. SOURCE B STATED THE RUSSIANS KNOW THIS AND TAKE ADVANTAGE OF THE SITUATION BY GDING CLOSE TO THE ARGENTINE CUAST WHERE THERE IS AN ABUNDANCE OF FISH. SOURCE A STATED THAT AN ARA P2 WHO HAPPENED TO BE ON PATROL (AFTER HAVING BEEN TIPPED OFF BY LOCAL FISHERMEN) WAS THE FIRST TO SPOT THE ALLEGED VIOLATION. WITH A TOTAL OF FIVE P2 NAVY PATROL AIRCRAFT, IT IS IMPOSSIBLE FOR THE ARA TO PROTECT ITS CLAIMED WATERS. DESPITE THESE DISADVANTAGES, THESE NAVAL ACTIVITIES COMBINE TO ENAHANCE THE REPUTATION OF THE POLITICALLY AMBITIOUS CINC OF THE NAVY, ADMIRAL MASSERA. IN TAKING ON THE RUSSIANS HE BECOMES SOMETHING OF A NATIONAL HERD. RUSSIAN REACTION AT PRESENT HAS BEEN LOW. PHOTOGRAPHS WILL BE FORWARDED BY SEPARATE LETTER. THIS MSG COORD W/EMBASSY.
