She stated that her company represents several European and US businesses, but is interested in identifying US firms that manufacture unusual types of military equipment. When asked to elaborate, she stated that her organization which has been in existance for seven years, has served as a point of contact for the Argentine Armed Forces to research, identify and procure military equipment for special requirements.

2. (G/NOFORN) Then source added that a logistics officer from the Argentine Army had requested her firm to obtain information on and locate a supplier for a non-lethal incapacitating weapon and for plastic explosives. Source commented that she believed that the Army had become sensitive to human rights criticism and was searching for a weapon that could be used to neutralize terrorisp without killing them. Source believed the best weapon to do the job would be an incapacitating gas or agent delivered either by hand or rifle grenade. When source was asked for what reason and in what volume the Argentine Army wanted plastic explosives, she stated she was not sure, but believed the purpose was to study the product.
