LEFT PERU FOLLOWING A MODERATE SPEECH GIVEN BY PRESIDENT MORALES BERMUDEZ, LEAVING SOME 300 TO 500 IN COUNTRY. SIN HAS BEEN ORDERED TO KEEP A CLOSER WATCH ON HAVANA'S PRESENCE, BUT IT SEEMS UNABLE TO IDENTIFY THE EXACT

CUBANS IN PERU, HOPING TO SPARK A GOVERNMENT CRACKDOWN ON ALL POTENTIAL SUBVERSIVES. THIS WOULD COINCIDE WITH THE PREVALENT FEELING AMONG SOME MILITARY LEADERS THAT THE CUBAN VICTORY IN ANGOLA HAS CONSEQUENCES FOR ADVERTURISM IN THIS HEMISPHERE.

3. ~~(S//NOFORN//NOCONTRACT//NOINTEL)~~ FOR SEVERAL REASONS, HAVANA HAS LITTLE CAUSE TO INCREASE ITS CONTINGENT IN PERU AT THIS TIME. RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES HAVE COOLED SOMEWHAT, AND HAVANA DOES NOT WISH TO SEE THEM RUPTURED BY CLANDESTINE ARRIVALS OF CUBANS. HAVANA'S LONG-TERM GOALS VIS-A-VIS LIMA MAY INCLUDE TRYING TO INSTALL A LEFTIST REGIME IN PERU, BUT FOR NOW CASTRO WILL MOVE CAREFULLY SINCE HE IS AWARE THAT THE US IS WATCHING HIS ACTIONS IN LATIN AMERICA. MOREOVER, HAVANA APPARENTLY DOES NOT WANT TO BE INVOLVED (80 PERCENT, B) IN THE DORMANT DISPUTE BETWEEN PERU AND CHILE, EVEN THOUGH SOME CHILEAN OFFICERS FEAR THIS OCCURRENCE. CUBAN PRESENCE IN PERU IS EXPECTED TO REMAIN STABLE (85 PERCENT, B), REFLECTING HAVANA'S DESIRE TO KEEP ITS MAJOR, ALTHOUGH SOMETIMES INDEPENDENT, ALLY ON THE SOUTH AMERICAN CONTINENT.
