

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22023 PAGE 3 CONFIDENTIAL STANDING CONCERNING THE PROCESS OF CONGRESSIONAL DETERMINA-TION OF FMS CREDITS AND THE POSSIBILITY THAT CONGRESS COULD TAKE ACTION TO LIMIT UTILIZATION OF CREDITS ALREADY AUTHORIZED, BUT NOT YET USED. APPARENTLY, MANY ARGAF OFFICERS FEEL THAT THE SECSTATE PROPOSAL IS THE LAST THEY WILL HEAR OF HUMAN RIGHTS AND FMS CREDITS UNTIL THE FY79 PROPOSAL IS TO BE MADE, SOURCE D SAYS HIS CONTACTS, WHO WORK IN THE ARGAF AGENCIES WHICH DEAL WITH CREDITS AND PURCHASES, ARE WELL AWARE OF THE TECHNICAL NUANCES OF FMS, BUT PERHAPS NOT AWARE OF THE CONGRESSIONAL ACTION YET TO COME. 4. TALL EXPRESSED CONCERN THAT THE USG ACTION HAD SERIOUSLY WEAKENED THE POSITION OF GOA MODERATES VIS A VIS THE HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUE. ALL THREE STATED THAT THOSE WITHIN THE GOVERNMENT IN FAVOR OR PRODUCING A COMPLETE LIST OF DETAINEES AND PUNISHING PERSONNEL KNOWN TO HAVE COMMITTED EXCESSES, ARE NOW UNABLE TO SUPPORT THEIR VIEWS WITHOUT BEING LABELED DISLOYAL TO THEIR COUNTRY, ALL THREE SOURCES USED THE EXAMPLE OF US AMBASSADOR BRADEN'S CAMPAIGN AGAINST JUAN PERON IN THE 1946 ELECTION TO EXPLAIN THE CURRENT REACTION TO THE US HUMAN RIGHTS CHARGES. THEY SAID THAT JUST AS VOTERS WERE CONVINCED TO VOTE FOR PERON AS A REACTION TO US INTERFERENCE THEN, MODERATES NOW FEEL PRESSURES TO DEFEND THE COUNTRY'S HONOR RATHER THAN SUPPORT US HUMAN RIGHTS CONCERNS. 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CONFIDENTIALL/NOFORN MAR 77 SECTION 2 OF 2 DOESN'T MAKE AUDITIONAL CHARGES OF HUMAN RIGHTS ABUSES IN ARGENTINA, IF USG DOES MAKE FURTHER CHARGES, THEY FEAR AN INCREASED HARDENING ON THE HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUE, AND EXACERBATING OF GOA-USG RELATIONS WHICH MODERATES WILL NOT BE ABLE TO CONFINE TO THE HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUE, SOURCES A & E STATED THAT IN THEIR JUDGEMENT THE LOSS OF LEVERAGE FOR MODERATES IN THE GOA HAS SPILLED OVER INTO ALL PHASES OF THE NATIONAL REORGANIZATION PROCESS, ALL THREE OF THESE SOURCES NOTED THAT BY CUTTING BACK THE PROPOSED FMS CREDITS, AND INCITING THE GOA REACTION OF REJECTING ALL FMS CREDITS FOR FY7B, THE USG HAD LOST A GREAT DEAL OF ITS LEVERAGE IN THE HUMAN RIGHTS DIALOGUE, IN ADDITION TO REDUCING THE POWER OF MODERATES WITHIN THE GOA, THE USG HAD FORFEITED A MAJOR VEHICLE FOR EXERTING PRESSURE THROUGH THE

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22013 ARGENTINE MILITARY, THESE SOURCES SEE DIMINISHED MODERATE. INFLUENCE IN GOA AS THE MOST IMPORTANT LONG RANGE RESULT OF THE FMS-CREDIT REDUCTIONS. 5. (C/NOFORM) SOURCES A. 8 AND C EMPHASIZED THAT THE ARGENTINE MILITARY IN GENERAL, AND THE ARGAF IN PARTICULAR, WILL DO EVERYTHING POSSIBLE TO MAINTAIN THE EXCELLENT RELATIONS WHICH EXIST WITH THEIR SISTER-SERVICES IN THE UNITED STATES, SOURCE A STATED THAT THE AFSEC IS IMPORTANT TO ARGAE FOR PROFESSIONAL AND DOCTRINAL REASONS, HE SAID THE AFSEC WOULD REMAIN IN ARGENTINA AS LONG AS THE INTERNAL POLITICAL REACTIONS TO USG MINTERVENTION IN OUR INTERNAL AFFAIRS" WOULD PERMIT, HE ADDED THAT AREAF-USAF RELATIONS WOULD BE ISOLATED FROM GOA-USG CONFLICTS AS MUCH AS POSSIBLE: SUGGESTING THAT EVEN IN THE MOST EXTREME CIRCUMSTANCES, THE ARGAF WOULD TRY IN SOME WAY TO KEEP THE AFSEC IN PLACE, BASED ON THE EXISTING BILATERAL TREATY, SOURCE O REPORTED ON 10 MAR 77, HOWEVER, THAT A PROPOSED UNIT VISIT TO AFSEC PERSONNEL WOULD HAVE TO BE POSTPONED UNTIL AFTER BRIG AGOSTI, CINC APGAF, HAD AN OPPORTUNITY TO TALK WITH GEN MCBRIDE, VICE CHIEF OF STAFF, USAF ON BILATERAL ISSUES OURING THE 17TH INTER AMERICAN AIR FORCE CHIEFS! COMMENT: (CYNDFORN) ARGENTINE NATIONAL PRIDE HAS REEN HURT, ON TWO COUNTS: A) ALLEGED USG INTERFEHENCE IN A DOMESTIC ISSUE AND B) COMPARING ARGENTINA WITH ETHIOPIA, SOUTH KOREA AND THE PHILIPPINES, THE COMPARISON WITH ETHIOPIA IS OFFENSIVE TO MANY ARGENTINES BECAUSE ARGENTINA CONSIDERS ITSELF ALMOST A DEVELOPED NATION, WHILE IT CONSIDERS ETHIOPIA AS A PART OF TRIBAL: BACKWARD AFRICA, THE COMPARISION WITH SOUTH KOREA AND THE PHILIPPINES HURTS THE ARGENTINE NATIONAL PRIDE BECAUSE IT IS A GRAPHIC DEMONSTRATION TO GOA OF THEIR LESSOR RELATIVE STRATEGIC IMPORTANCE TO THE USG. COMPARED TO THE REACTION OF URUGUAY AND BRAZIL TO FMS REDUCTIONS, THE GOA REACTION HAS BEEN MODERATE AND CAREFULLY ARTICULATED TO CONFINE THE ISSUE, THE STRONG INITIAL INTERNAL REACTION, AND THE LOSS OF LEVERAGE FOR MODERATES IN THE GOA, COULD MEAN A MARDENING OF POSITIONS WITHIN THE GOA ON THE HUMAN RIGHTS ISSUE. AS WELL AS A MORE EMOTIONAL REACTION TO FURTHER USG ACTIONS WHICH LINK HUMAN RIGHTS TO US-ARGENTINE BILATERAL RELATIONS. THIS HIS HAS BEEN COORDWIEMBASSY

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
