2. (U) Additionally, and since press release of above summary, yet another military victim has been added with the death of Colonel (Coronel) Julio Larrabure who had been kidnapped on 10 Aug 74. This latest reported victim had, according to kidnappers, committed suicide. However, Army Headquarters upon receipt of body 23 Aug 75, ordered an autopsy which subsequently showed that the body, which had been frozen, had been subjected to beatings and other mal treatments which was the cause of death.

3. ~~C/NPD~~ CMT: In none of the above reported incidents has there been capture of the villains. In every incident the assassin has escaped. The Military Sector has been keeping cool in not retaliating in spite of the deaths - but, their boiling point may be approaching.
