15. SUMMARY: (C//NOFORN) This IR provides information on the ERP/Montonero terrorist intelligence apparatus and is based on conclusions drawn from guerrilla intelligence material captured on 8 Jan 76.

This IR partially fulfills

1. (C//NOFORN) On 8 Jan 1977 combined security forces (Armed Forces, Federal Police and National Gendarmerie) raided a safe house which was reportedly operated by the Montoneros and ERP terrorists. The haven was believed to be a guerrilla operations center and afforded the security forces an insight into the insurgent intelligence collection capability.
2. (S//NOFORN) On 22 Jan 76, the Director of Intelligence of the National Gendarmerie visited RO and presented a package

of documents which consisted of a number of photo copies taken from a microfilm captured during the 8 January raid. The documents contained names, addresses, and positions of Argentine Police and Gendarmerie officers who had attended US schools under the auspices of USAID programs. The Director of Intelligence suspected that the photo copies had been obtained in the US Embassy and was concerned that a terrorist had infiltrated the US Embassy Staff. Subsequent analysis of the photo copies by the [] Legal Attache (LEGATT) and Regional Security Officer (RSO) established that the basic data had come from a document prepared in the US Embassy in support of the AID program. It was also learned that the unclassified document which was published in 1970 had received widespread distribution within the Argentine Federal Police, Provincial Police and National Gendarmerie. The terrorists had been updating the information and annotations no older than 18 months were discovered.

3. (~~SECRET/NOFORN~~) In early February during a subsequent meeting with the Gendarmerie Intelligence Chief, it was learned that the original package of documents provided [] represented only a portion of the frames contained in the microfilm. He informed [] that the Federal Police had the microfilm and wished to share some of the contents with the US. The Director of Intelligence of the Federal Police provided [] seventy-two (72) prints taken from the microfilm. Additionally, there were approximately 40-50 other prints which he retained. The latter group consisted of information that terrorists had gathered on the Argentine business community. The following is a breakdown of the information contained on the microfilm:

a. Group of twenty-three (23) pages showing the names of security officers that had attended US law enforcement schools in the United States under the auspices of USAID. The document contained addresses and phone numbers of the student, his former and post-course positions and USAID funding data. The basic information was copied from a 1970 USAID document and had been updated with data, some of which was no older than 18 months. The Montoneros/ERP apparently obtained the AID document from one of those distributed to the Police or National Gendarmerie. There was no evidence to support the theory that an Embassy employee had passed the document to the terrorists. A sample of these pages is shown as enclosure (1).

b. The second group of twenty-three (23) photographs consists of a roster of US Embassy personnel who served in Buenos Aires during the period 1967. The roster lists the personnel, provides their titles, home and office addresses, and telephone numbers. The origin of this document was apparently a Diplomatic listing produced by the Argentine Foreign Ministry. See Enclosure (2) for sample.

c. The third group of five (5) pages consists of a diplomatic list that dates to late 1974. Embassy officials and their wives are shown along with their positions, date of arrival on station and office phone number. The source of this group is the Argentine Foreign Ministry. Enclosure (3) shows page of the roster.

d. The fourth group of twelve (12) pages consists of data gathered on US Embassy personnel (mostly USMILGP) and some of their activities. The majority of the information was collected during the 1969-71 time frame and includes a list of USMILGP automobiles. The ERP/Montoneros apparently obtained this data when they attacked a contract guard service (MILGP contract) patrol car in the years 1970 and 1971 and confiscated material provided to the guards. See Enclosures (4) and (5).

e. A fifth grouping of four (4) pages represents news clippings on a US Air Force mission in Mendoza which phased out in early 1974.

f. An additional two pages consisted of information collected on personnel who they believed were CIA informants, or CIA personnel. This data has been passed to SRF.

g. The last group consists of 3 pages of call signs used by the US Embassy Security Radio Net several years ago. The insurgents apparently have monitored the net and tried to match names to addresses and call signs. The source of this information is believed to be employees of a contract guard service that operated the radio service approximately three years ago. See Enclosure (6).

4. COMMENT: ~~(S//WHINTEL//NOFORN)~~ The information collected by the ERP/Montoneros is not terribly important since the majority of it is old and out of date. What is significant, however, is the fact that the terrorists have been collecting information, obtaining it from a variety of sources for a number of years, and have recorded their data base on microfilm and have probably distributed it to their operatives in the field. (It is believed that security forces captured a similar film during another raid). These factors strongly suggest that the guerrilla intelligence apparatus, both for collection and colation is well developed and has been for sometime. The disturbing question now is how much more information is in the hands of the terrorists- where it is located and how it will be used. Hopefully, the Armed Forces and police have been successful in disrupting the subversive's intelligence system and that future operations (under a military government) will be even more effective.
