THE NUMBER OF CUBAN CIVILIAN INSTRUCTORS IN PANAMA VARIES CONTINUALLY, BUT IS BELIEVED TO BE FAIRLY SMALL. WHILE MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE PAREDES ALSO REPORTEDLY INFORMED
