(C/NF) ACCORDING TO SOURCE, ON 910107, THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, GENERAL ANTONIO ((RIVIELLO)) BAZAN, BROKE A LONG STANDING TABU AGAINST IMPRISONING HIGH RANKING OFFICERS OF THE ARMY ORDERING THE ARREST AND INCARCERATION OF THREE GENERAL OFFICERS, ONE COLONEL, ONE LIEUTENANT COLONEL, ONE CAPTAIN, TWO LIEUTENANTS AND ONE CORPORAL. THE ACTIONS WERE TAKEN TO COMPLY WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE NATIONAL HUMAN RIGHTS COMMISSION (CNDH).

2. <del>(C/NF)</del> THE THIRTEEN SOLDIERS ORIGINALLY INVOLVED IN THE FIREFIGHT WERE NOT JAILED SINCE NO PROOF OR EVIDENCE WAS PRESENTED AGAINST THEM. ACCORDING TO SOURCE, THEY WERE ONLY FOLLOWING ORDERS.

3. (C/NF) BRIGADIER GENERAL JORGE ((BACA)) GONZALEZ AND LIEUTENANT ENRIQUE ((ZUNIGA)) GERARDO WERE SET FREE BY THE MILITARY JUDGE. HOWEVER, LIEUTENANT GENERAL ALFREDO ((MORAN)) ACEVEDO, MAJOR GENERAL HUMBERTO ((MARTINEZ)) LOPEZ, LIEUTENANT JOSE ALFREDO ((CORONEL)) VARGAS, COLONEL NICOLAS ((SANCHEZ)) SOSA, CORPORAL LUCIO ((MELAGA)) ESCRIBANO AND CAPTAIN VICTOR MANUEL ((JIMENEZ)) AZCONA WERE ALL ORDERED TO BE IMPRISONED BY THE MILITARY TOP JUDGE.
