SECRETARY OF DEFENSE, GENERAL ANTONIO ((RIVIELLO))
BAZAN, BROKE A LONG STANDING TABU AGAINST IMPRISONING
HIGH RANKING OFFICERS OF THE ARMY ORDERING THE ARREST
AND INCARCERATION OF THREE GENERAL OFFICERS, ONE
COLONEL, ONE LIEUTENANT COLONEL, ONE CAPTAIN, TWO
LIEUTENANTS AND ONE CORPORAL. THE ACTIONS WERE TAKEN
TO COMPLY WITH THE RECOMMENDATION OF THE NATIONAL HUMAN
RIGHTS COMMISSION (CNDH).

2. ~~(C/NF)~~ THE THIRTEEN SOLDIERS ORIGINALLY INVOLVED
IN THE FIREFIGHT WERE NOT JAILED SINCE NO PROOF OR
EVIDENCE WAS PRESENTED AGAINST THEM. ACCORDING TO
SOURCE, THEY WERE ONLY FOLLOWING ORDERS.

3. ~~(C/NF)~~ BRIGADIER GENERAL JORGE ((BACA)) GONZALEZ
AND LIEUTENANT ENRIQUE ((ZUNIGA)) GERARDO WERE SET FREE
BY THE MILITARY JUDGE. HOWEVER, LIEUTENANT GENERAL
ALFREDO ((MORAN)) ACEVEDO, MAJOR GENERAL HUMBERTO
((MARTINEZ)) LOPEZ, LIEUTENANT JOSE ALFREDO ((CORONEL))
VARGAS, COLONEL NICOLAS ((SANCHEZ)) SOSA, CORPORAL
LUCIO ((MELAGA)) ESCRIBANO AND CAPTAIN VICTOR MANUEL
((JIMENEZ)) AZCONA WERE ALL ORDERED TO BE IMPRISONED BY
THE MILITARY TOP JUDGE.

4. ~~(C/NF)~~ LTG MORAN, THE MILITARY ZONE COMMANDER, IS
CHARGED WITH BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR THE VIOLENT DEATHS
OF THE SEVENFEDERAL AGENTS, WITH DISOBEDIENCE OF
ORDERS, AND WITH CONDUCT UNBECOMING AN OFFICER OF THE
ARMY AND A PUBLIC SERVANT. HE IS PRESENTLY IN JAIL.

5. ~~(C/NF)~~ MG MARTINEZ IS CHARGED WITH BEING AN
ACCOMPLICE TO ILLEGAL VIOLENCE AGAINST PERSONS

RESULTING IN DEATH, AND CONDUCT UNBECOMING A MILITARY OFFICER. HE IS PRESENTLY IN JAIL.

6. ~~(C/NF)~~ COLONEL SANCHEZ IS ALSO ACCUSED OF CONDUCT UNBECOMING AN OFFICER AS WELL AS BEING AN ACCOMPLICE TO VIOLENCE RESULTING IN DEATH. HE IS IN JAIL.

7. ~~(C/NF)~~ LT CORONEL, IN ADDITION TO BEING CHARGED FOR THE SAME ACTS AS COLONEL SANCHEZ ABOVE, IS ALSO BEING INVESTIGATED FOR ALLOWING THE TWO DRUG TRAFFICKERS IN DRUG LADENED PLANE TO ESCAPE. HE IS IN JAIL.

8. ~~(C/NF)~~ CPT JIMENEZ WAS CHARGED WITH BEING RESPONSIBLE FOR VIOLENCE AGAINST PERSONS CAUSING

INJURY. HE IS IN JAIL.

9. ~~(C/NF)~~ SOURCE STATES THAT THE SECRETARY OF DEFENSE BROKE THE TABU AGAINST IMPRISONING HIGH RANKING ARMY OFFICERS, BY COMPLYING WITH THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CNDH.

10. SOURCE FURTHER STATES THAT THE GENERAL PUBLIC OF MEXICO HAS REACTED POSITIVELY TO THE SECDEF'S ACTIONS AND RESPECT FOR THE MILITARY INSTITUTION HAS INCREASED GREATLY WITH POPULAR SUPPORT FOR BRINGING TO JUSTICE THOSE RESPONSIBLE FOR THE DEATHS OF THE SEVEN AGENTS.
