THE SAME DAY, FORTY ELN CAPTURED A FINCA NEAR SAN ALBERTO (b)(3):10 USC 424 AFTER ACCUSING HIM OF INFORMING TO THE ARMY, THE GUERRILLAS KILLED THE MANAGER IN FRONT OF THE RANCH'S WORKERS. - C.
