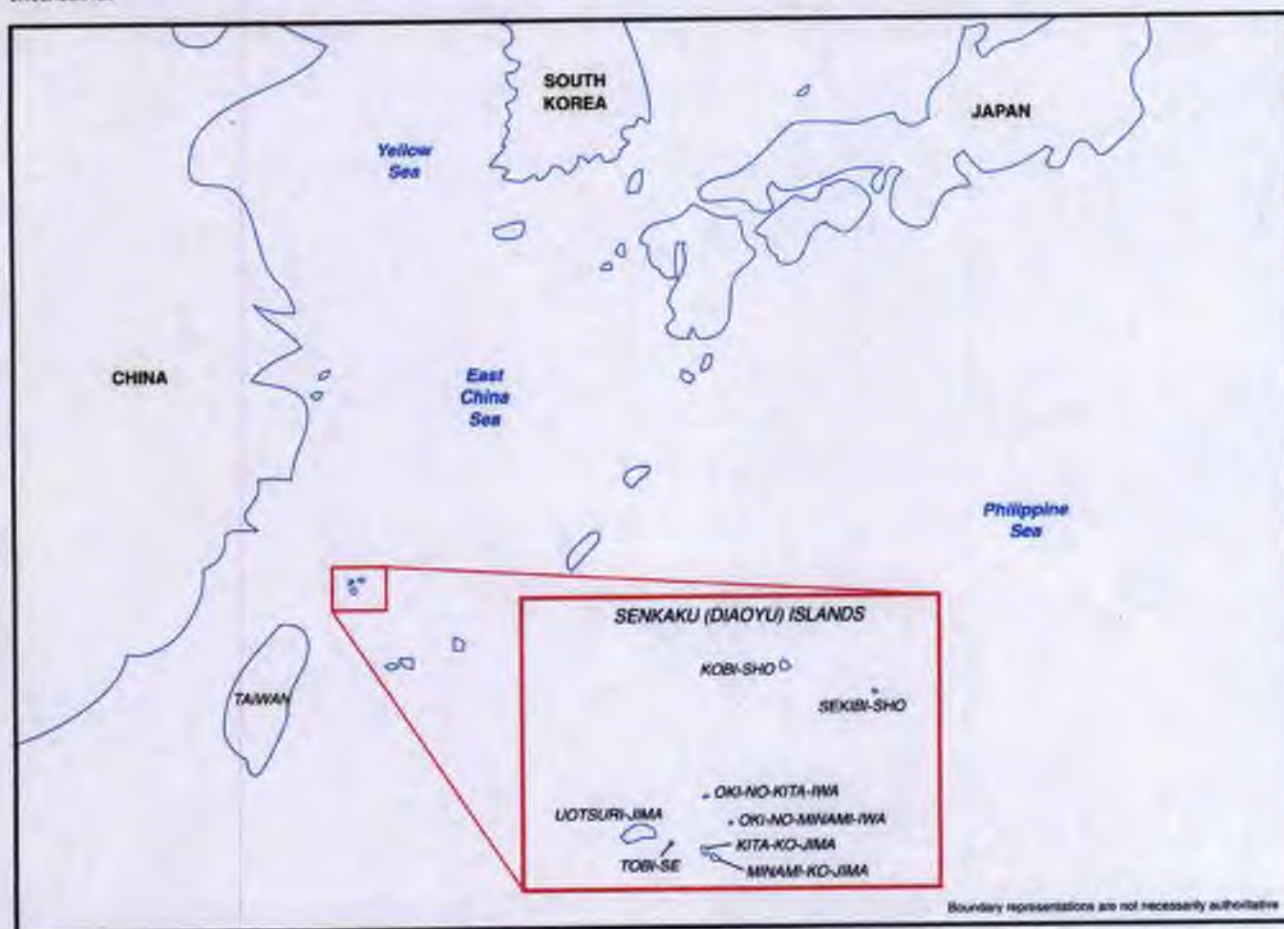

(U) Tokyo has responded to increased Chinese marine research ship activity in Japan's Exclusive Economic Zone and the dispatch of Chinese warships to an area near the Senkakus by formally protesting to the Chinese government. Tokyo urged Beijing to stop its research activities and reiterated its proposal to hold a second round of bilateral talks on territorial issues and the UN Law of the Sea. China thus far has stated its officials are too busy to hold such talks.
