SUSPECT AHMAD RIBHI ((SHALABI)) 20 YRS IN THE JENIN REFUGEE CAMP; THREE PIJ SUSPECTS -- HANI MUHAMMAD HAMED ((AWAYS)) 19 YRS, MUHAMMAD FARIS HAMED ((AWAYS)) 17 YRS, AND IBRAHIM HUSSAYN ((BRAYTEM)) 20 YRS -- IN QALQILYA; AND PIJ SUSPECT MUHAMMAD HATEM ((AZIZ)) 24 YRS OLD IN BAQA AL SHARQIYA.

PIJ MEMBER ABDUL RAHMAN QASSAM RAGHEB AL ((SAADI)) 17 YRS FROM THE JENIN REFUGEE CAMP, TO 45 MONTHS IN PRISON FOR SHOOTING AND EXPLOSIVE CHARGE ATTACKS, AND ASSISTING FUGITIVES; PIJ MEMBER MUHAMMAD AHMAD FARIS ((DAQEM)) 20 YRS OLD FROM THE JENIN REFUGEE CAMP, TO 18 MONTHS IN PRISON FOR ASSISTING FUGITIVES; TANZIM MEMBER MUHAMMAD TALIB IBRAHIM ((GHAWADREH)) 23 YRS OLD FROM BIR AL BASHA VILLAGE, TO 33 MONTHS IN PRISON FOR SHOOTING AND EXPLOSIVE CHARGE ATTACKS, AND ASSISTING FUGITIVES; PIJ MEMBER HAMED YUSIF ((HARUB)) FROM WADI FUKIN, TO FOUR YEARS IN PRISON FOR ASSISTING FUGITIVES, AND EXPLOSIVE CHARGE ATTACKS; AND AL AQSA MARTYRS' BRIGADE MEMBER MUHAMMAD AYSA ((AWED)) 25 YEARS OLD FROM YATA, TO LIFE I PRISON FOR SHOOTING AND EXPLOSIVE CHARGE ATTACKS, AND ASSISTING A SUICIDE BOMBER.

C. (U) OTHER:

-- (U) SHARON-ABBAS MEETING. PM ARIEL ((SHARON)) MET WITH PA PRES MAHMUD ((ABBAS)) ON TUESDAY AFTERNOON IN THEIR FIRST MEETING SINCE THE SHARM AL SHAYKH SUMMIT IN EARLY FEBRUARY -- NO NEW GROUND WAS BREACHED. SHARON PRESSED THE PA TO DO MORE AGAINST TERROR GROUPS. ABBAS CONDEMNED RECENT TERROR ATTACKS, STATING THAT "EVERY BULLET AND MORTAR FIRED AT YOU IS ALSO FIRED AT ME." ABBAS COMPLAINED THAT ISRAEL WAS NOT DOING ENOUGH TO STRENGTHEN HIS GOVERNMENT IN ORDER FOR IT TO TACKLE TERRORISM. NONETHELESS, ABBAS AGREED TO COORDINATE THE ASPECTS OF THE ISRAELI DISENGAGEMENT PLAN, DEPLOY PA SECURITY FORCES TO ASSIST IN CALMING THE SITUATION, AND ACCEPTED A PROPOSAL THAT THE GOI

DESTROY SETTLERS HOMES AND THE PA REMOVE THE DEBRIS. SHARON OFFERED, ACCORDING TO THE PRESS, TO TURN OVER SECURITY RESPONSIBILITY TO THE PA IN BETHLEHEM AND QALQILYA DURING THE NEXT TWO WEEKS. HE ALSO REPORTEDLY AGREED TO INCREASE THE NUMBER OF PALESTINIANS WORKING IN ISRAEL, IMPROVE FREEDOM OF MOVEMENT, AND RELEASE SOME VETERAN PRISONERS WITH "BLOOD ON THEIR HANDS". SHARON REFUSED TO PROVIDE ADDITIONAL ARMS TO THE PA, AND TO RELEASE SENIOR PRISONERS IN THE JERICHO JAIL. HE WAS NOT FORTHCOMING ON THE AIRPORT, BUT REPORTEDLY WOULD ALLOW THE PA TO BEGIN WORK ON A PORT FACILITY.

-- (U) A TRAIN STRUCK A TRUCK AT A RAIL CROSSING IN THE NORTHERN NEGEV ON TUESDAY, KILLING SEVEN PEOPLE AND INJURING MORE THAN 195 -- AT LEAST 20 ARE IN SERIOUS CONDITION.

-- (U) THE HIGH COURT OF JUSTICE REJECTED A PETITION AGAINST THE "FENCE" IN JERUSALEM , STATING THAT THE STATE HAD THE RIGHT TO BUILD ON ITS LAND.
