SUMMARY: (C) DETERIORATING SECURITY SITUATION ALONG MOZAMBIQUE-SOUTH AFRICAN BORDER PROMPTS FIRST VISIT TO MAPUTO OF NEW SA DEFENSE MINISTER. DESPITE COMRADELY EXCHANGE OF GOOD OLE DAYS, TWO SIDES FAIL TO AGREE ON SUBSTANTIVE ISSUES. NKOMATI ACCORD DIES NATURAL DEATH.

(U) IN A HASTILY ARRANGED VISIT WITHO UT PUBLICITY AND FANFARE ON THE EVE OF SOUTH AFRICAN PRESIDENT NELSON ((MANDELA))'S FIRST OFFICIAL TRIP OUTSIDE SOUTH AFRICA, THE NEW SOUTH AFRICAN DEFENSE MINISTER, MR JOE ((MODISE)), ARRIVED IN MAPUTO ABOARD A ROUTINE SOUTH AFRICAN AIRWAYS (SAA) FLIGHT ON 940715 FOR HIS FIRST OFFICIAL VISIT TO MOZAMBIQUE. MR MODISE MET WITH HIS MOZAMBICAN COUNTERPART, GENERAL ALBERTO ((CHIPANDE)), AND SEVERAL OTHER SENIOR MOZAMBICAN OFFICIALS. MR MODISE THEN QUIETLY DEPARTED ABOARD ANOTHER ROUTINE SAA FLIGHT LATE ON THE SAME AFTERNOON.

VISIT HAS PROMPTED IN PART BY THE IMPENDING MANDELA VISIT AS WELL AS THE RAPIDLY DETERIORATING SECURITY SITUATION ALONG THE MOZAMBICAN-SOUTH AFRICAN BORDER AND THE COMPLETE ABSENCE OF MOZAMBICAN COOPERATION ON BORDER ISSUES. IN PARTICULAR, [redacted] THE BORDER AREA FROM THE BORDER GATE CROSSING AT THE INTERSECTION OF THE SWAZILAND-MOZAMBICAN-SOUTH AFRICAN BORDER TO THE BORDER TOWN OF RESSANO GARCIA/ [redacted]

ALMOST DAILY ALONG THIS SECTION OF THE BORDER. [REDACTED]

WITH SOUTH AFRICAN NATIONAL DEFENSE FORCE (SANDF)  
SOLDIERS AS MOZAMBICANS SEARCH FOR WEAK POINTS ALONG  
THE BORDER. IN THE PAST SEVERAL WEEKS, SEVERAL GUN  
BATTLES HAVE TAKEN PLACE AT ELECTRICAL GENERATOR  
STATIONS THAT PROVIDE POWER TO THE BORDER FENCE. TO  
COMBAT THE PROBLEM, [REDACTED] SANDF HAS DEPLOYED  
A TOTAL OF 600 TROOPS WHO CONDUCT VEHICLE AND FOOT  
PATROLS. [REDACTED] THE SITUATION AS "MISSION  
IMPOSSIBLE" DUE TO THE MOUNTAINOUS TERRAIN, INADEQUATE

DIRECTOR OF IMMIGRATION, MR MIGUEL ((CHISSANO)), THE  
CHIEF OF CUSTOMS, MR VIEGAS ((MAHUMANE)), THE CHIEF OF  
STAFF AND ACTING SUPERINTENDENT OF THE MOZAMBICAN  
NATIONAL POLICE, SUPERINTENDENT BENEDITO

ROOM. FOR THE FIRST TWO HOURS, THE TWO TRADED STORIES  
ABOUT THEIR RESPECTIVE DAYS IN THE LIBERATION

6. (C) WHEN THE MEETING TURNED TO BORDER ISSUES,  
HOWEVER, THE FORMER JOVIAL ATMOSPHERE SUDDENLY BECAME  
QUITE HARSH. MINISTER MODISE POINTED TO THE ARRAY OF  
PROBLEMS ALONG THE BORDER AND SOLICITED MOZAMBICAN (b)(1),1.4 (c)  
COOPERATION. [REDACTED] GENERAL CHIPANDE  
BLAMED THE ACTIVITY ON RENAMO AND A LACK OF RESOURCES  
OF THE "OZAMBICAN SIDE OF THE BORDER. TO THE SURPRISE  
OF "INISTER MODISE, GENERAL CHIPANDE THEN CLAIMED THAT  
THE MOZAMBICANS HAVE NO CONTROL OF THE BORDER AREA AND  
CANNOT INFLUENCE ACTIVITIES IN THAT AREA.

7. (C) OF PARTICULAR INTEREST, THE TWO SIDES THEN  
DISCUSSED THE MECHANISMS FOR COOPERATION ON BORDER  
ISSUES PREVIOUSLY ESTABLISHED UNDER THE N'KOMATI  
ACCORD. RATHER THAN RETAIN THE ACCORD'S JOINT  
SECURITY COMMISSION (JSC), THE MOZAMBICAN AGREED TO  
SET-UP A JOINT POLICE AND DEFENSE COMMISSION (JPDC)  
WITH PARTICIPATION FROM POLICE, CUSTOMS, IMMIGRATION,
