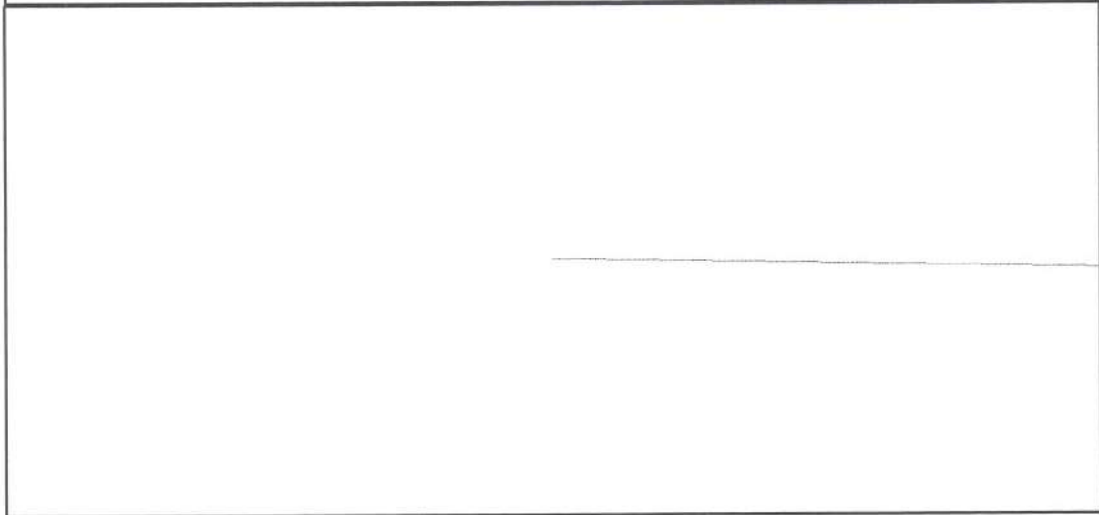

SHOULD ANYTHING HAPPEN THAT WOULD CAUSE MANDELA TO VACATE THE OFFICE OF PRESIDENT, THE DIPLOMATS BELIEVE THAT THE INTERNAL STABILITY SITUATION WILL DETERIORATE QUICKLY.
